OTHER IMPORTANT NOTES

- At check in, each Family Camp participant will be given a pink band for activity and meal access. We ask that you please wear it the whole weekend.
- At the pool, we also require all swimmers under the age of 16 to be swim tested and marked with a colored wrist band. Please help our lifeguards keep our waterfronts safe!
- On the discovery course and at the stables, all participants must have closed-toe shoes, and long pants are necessary when horseback riding.
- Kids club will be available during activity blocks at the Sport Court. Please make a reservations at check in.
- Please keep track of your children and especially monitor them around bodies of water!
- Please, no pets, bikes, smoking (including vapes, etc), inflatables in the pool (unless they are Coast Guard-approved) or alcoholic beverages.

DRIVING AT CAMP

Should you need to drive on "Camelback Road" (our interior camp road), please ensure all riders have seatbelts, and drive slowly. Camelback is a "down only," so to go from the valley to Lakeview, please drive out the valley drive and go back in the main entrance. For the main gate, please use code *1950

VISIT THE HORSES AT THE STABLES

Sign up for a trail ride during check in. Trail riders must be at least nine years old and under 200 pounds. Ring Rides are available on Sunday from 3:00-4:00pm and Monday from 12:00-1:00pm. Please make sure children have closed toe shoes on. Barn visitors are welcome during the day to see the horses or animals in the petting zoo.
